### Possum perhaps?

Never predictable, the menu at Tukka in West End continues to challenge the tastebuds. This winter's star dish combines the popular Granny Smith apple with something far less run of the mill – possum. French-born chef Stephane Bremont is pairing Pommerert apple with Tasmanian possum, Davidson's plum stuffing,

coconut and lemon myrtle cabbage, *above*. "In France, a dish like this would be a delicacy," Stephane says, "and people here are beginning to appreciate our speciality cuisine in the same way.
